Little Angels Service Dogs is a charitable, non-profit 501c3 corporation that reaches across all of the United States partnering service dogs with the disabled.

Our charitable goals also reach out to individuals throughout the United States, providing instruction on how to self-train their own service dogs to assist with their disabilities

At 8 weeks old our Puppies-In-Training go into foster homes where they are raised, loved and trained in individual homes provided by our fosters, trainers, and puppy raisers. Dogs are taken into public settings for socialization and training amidst distraction on a weekly basis from the time the puppies are only 8 weeks of age. Once the dog is mature enough for more advanced training it comes in for Boarding School at our training facility in Jamul, California. This enables our trainers to focus on the dog's specialized tasks to assist their scheduled recipient.

It is the goal of Little Angels that service dogs be placed at little to no cost to the disabled handler.

Little Angels is a 501c3 non-profit organization, and all donations are tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law.

Little Angels relies fully on the generosity of time given by our volunteers, and those who wish to contribute financially so that recipients do not have to pay to receive a service dog.

Autism Assistance

Dog4Jake



Our youngest, Jake (5), was diagnosed with Autism a few years ago. He has recently been approved for an Autism Service Dog through Little Angels Service Dogs, a non-profit in San Diego. Little Angels trains service dogs to assist kids with Autism, like Jake. They will train Jake's dog to help him with his specific needs. Jake elopes, which means that if we are not constantly holding him, or have him secured some other way, he will run away from us. The dog will be trained to be tethered to Jake, so that when Jake tries to "run", the dog will lie down, keeping Jake safe with us. This will help us in so many ways. One being for our family, so we will not have to hold him or keep him in a stroller for safety. But most important, I believe, will be the independence this will give to Jake, allowing him the freedom to move and explore in a safe way. Since Jake does run, there have been times when he has gotten away from us, thankfully, we were aware and he didn't get far. The dog will also be trained to track Jake, so that if the unthinkable does happen, we will have the dog to help us find him. Medical Alert is another way the dog will be trained, alerting us to some of Jake's repetitive behaviors. Most importantly, the dog will be trained to provide deep pressure, which will work like a comforting "hug", providing Jake with sensory input to help him regulate. Over time, the dog will learn to sense Jake's moods, and be there for him when he is feeling overwhelmed or overstimulated. This will allow Jake to feel safe in overwhelming environments.

There are so many more benefits to Jake having a service dog. As he grows, it will offer him more independence, giving him a chance to learn to navigate this world on his own. As well as learning a sense of responsibility, having to care for his dog, learning to feed him, brush him, and walk him. It will offer Jake more opportunities for social interaction, as well as encouraging him to communicate with the dog, and other people. Jake is an amazing, sweet, and extremely intelligent boy, and we are so excited at this opportunity for him.

So now, we are asking for your help. Little Angels Service Dogs is a non-profit, that relies on donations to train and provide these dogs at no cost to their approved recipients. There are currently over 80 people on their fundraising list, so we have decided to assist in fundraising in hopes to speed up the estimated on average wait time of a year. We are so thankful for this opportunity and are incredibly grateful to all who are able to help us.
