A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE,
APPROVING A REQUEST TO PURSUE A 24-MONTH PROJECT ADVERTISEMENT AND
CONSTRUCTION AWARD DELAY FROM THE ORANGE COUNTY TRANSPORTATION
AUTHORITY (OCTA) FOR THE EUCLID-WESTMINSTER INTERSECTION
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (PROJECT NO. 19-GGRV-ICE-3938)

WHEREAS, the City of Garden Grove applied for a grant under the Intersection Capacity Enhancement Program (ICE) requesting funding from the Orange County Transportation Authority;

WHEREAS, the right-of-way addition of a southbound right-turn lane and an eastbound right-turn lane at the intersection of Euclid Street and Westminster Avenue would be funded by the grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Garden Grove has been working with communication companies and Southern California Edison on scheduling delays relocating infrastructure for the project to begin.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. That the Director of Public Works and/or City Engineer is hereby authorized to request a 24-month project advertisement and construction award delay from the Orange County Transportation Authority for the Euclid-Westminster Intersection Improvement Project (Project No. 19-GGRV-ICE-3938).
- Section 2. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
