A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE PROCLAIMING THE TERMINATION OF THE LOCAL EMERGENCY DUE TO CIVIL UNREST DECLARED ON JUNE 2, 2020.

WHEREAS on June 9, 2020 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 9638-20 ratifying the City Manager/Director of Emergency Services' proclamation of a local emergency on June 2, 2020 due to civil unrest arising out of the death on May 25, 2020 of George Floyd during his arrest in which an officer of the Minneapolis Police Department kneeled on his neck to detain him during the arrest, and then did not respond to Mr. Floyd's requests for help when he stated that he could not breathe; and

WHEREAS, the death of George Floyd gave rise to protests that unfortunately turned to violence, looting, and property damage in various metropolitan areas across the United States, including surrounding and nearby cities; and

WHEREAS, ongoing protests in the last two weeks have been peaceful and the violence has stopped.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Garden Grove that the local emergency due to civil unrest declared on June 2, 2020 is hereby terminated.
