- <u>Section 1.</u> Certifies that said Applicant has or will have available, prior to commencement of work on the project included in this application, the sufficient funds to complete the project.
- <u>Section 2.</u> Certifies that if the project is awarded, the Applicant has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project.
- <u>Section 3.</u> Certifies that the Applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the contract shown in the Grant Administration Guide.
- <u>Section 4.</u> Delegates the authority to the City Manager, Community Services Director, or their designee(s) to conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the Grant Scope.
- <u>Section 5.</u> Agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and guidelines.
- <u>Section 6.</u> Will consider promoting inclusion per Public Resources Code §80001(b)(8A-G).
