Vaccination PODs (Points of Distribution)

- We have registered and assisted with vaccinating close to 1,100 Garden Grove seniors since February
- Built great collaborative relationships with Garden Grove Hospital and Christ Cathedral

Meal Distribution

- 2,000 meals to seniors weekly
- 300 to 400 food boxes to families through the City's two Family Resource Centers

Sports Fields

- Competitive sports - only soccer, baseball and football have been allowed to return. 40% of our field use capacity is permitted at this time
- Sports such as tennis and outdoor badminton are currently permitted to include doubles
- Indoor sports are not permitted until the Yellow tier

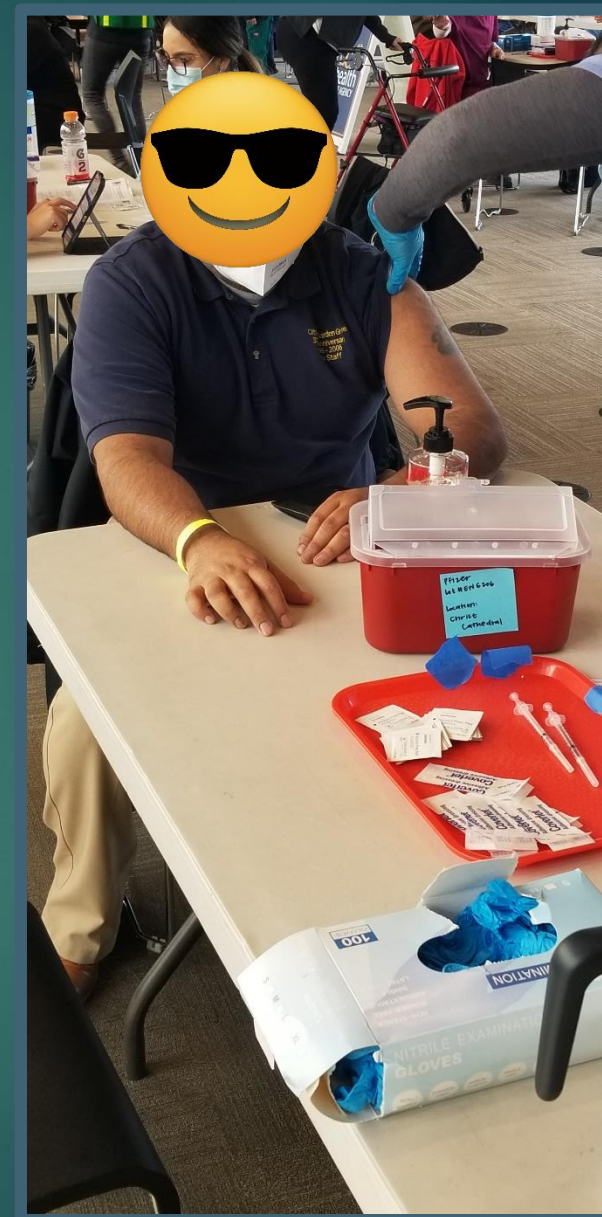
