The Honorable City of Garden Grove City Council:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT pursuant to Code Section 2.60.020, R.J. Noble Co. ("RJNC") hereby submits a Notice of Appeal with the City Clerk for the City of Garden Grove as a result of the awarding of the "VARIOUS STREETS REHABILITATION 2022" Project to All American Asphalt ("AAA") on, or about, May 11, 2022.

This Notice of Appeal is based on the belief that AAA's bid was non-responsive as a matter of law, and as a result, should not have been accepted nor considered by the City of Garden Grove's City Engineer, Navin Maru.

The bid provided by AAA was non-responsive for the following reasons discussed more fully below: (1) AAA's bid was not in accordance with the requirements set forth in the City of Garden Grove's Notice Inviting Sealed Bids for Various Streets Rehabilitation 2022 Project; (2) AAA had gross typographical and/or arithmetical errors, such that, AAA's bid should have been withdrawn without forfeiting its Bid Bond per Public Contract Code section 5103; and (3) AAA was improperly provided advantages in the bidding process which disadvantaged the other bidders in contravention of California public contract law.

I. **AAA'S BID WAS NOT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THE NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS**

Teresa Pomeroy, the City Clerk for the City of Garden Grove, submitted a "NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS FOR VARIOUS STREETS REHABILITATION 2022 PROJECT" ("Notice of Bid Invitation") on April 12, 2022, with publication dates of both April 15, 2022, and April 22, 2022. (See Exhibit A.)

Specifically, AAA's bid failed to comply with the Notice of Bid Invitation sections (1) and (3). Section (1) provided:

*Sealed Bids, marked "VARIOUS STREETS REHABILITATION 2022" will be received by the City Clerk in the City Hall, 11222 Acacia Parkway, Garden Grove, California until **11:00 a.m.**, on **Wednesday, May 11, 2022**, at which time they will be publicly opened in the 1-South Conference Room in City Hall (1st floor). [Italics added.]*

The Garden Grove City Hall lobby is temporarily closed for construction. Bidders can hand deliver their bid proposals at the back door of the City Hall prior to or by the deadline. The bid opening will be teleconferenced; teleconferencing information will be made available at least 7 days ahead of the bid opening date.

AAA's bid failed to conform to these requirements for a number of reasons: (1) the bid was not sealed at the time of delivery; (2) the bid was not submitted to the proper location of 11222 Acacia Parkway, Garden Grove, California, but was instead submitted to 12860 Acacia Parkway, Garden Grove, California; and (3) the bid was not submitted by the stated deadline of 11:00 a.m.

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First, employees for R.J. Noble witnessed AAA's runner with an opened envelope parked at 12860 Acacia Parkway at, or after, 11:00 a.m. (See attached declaration.) Furthermore, the same employees for R.J. Noble witnessed the AAA runner placing documents into said opened envelope in the parking lot as described above. (See attached declaration.) Finally, the same employees for R.J. Noble witnessed the AAA runner hand the **UNSEALED** bid to an employee for the City of Garden Grove, who then entered the building at 11222 Acacia Parkway at 11:02 a.m. by using a keypad at the back door. (See attached declaration.) As such, AAA failed to conform with the Notice of Bid Invitation by failing to submit a timely, conforming bid.

Second, AAA failed to deliver their bid to the proper address as stated in the Notice of Bid Invitation. This Notice of Bid Invitation clearly states that all bids shall be delivered to 11222 Acacia Parkway, Garden Grove, California. In addition, the Notice Bid Invitation expressly provides that the bids were to be hand delivered to the back door of the City Hall. However, AAA failed in delivering their bid to the proper address. Instead, **AAA delivered its bid to 12860 Acacia Parkway, Garden Grove, California.** Therefore, AAA failed to conform with the Notice of Bid Invitation express requirements in a material way by failing to hand deliver their sealed bid to the proper location.

Third, AAA failed to timely deliver their bid by the unwaivable and mandatory deadline of 11:00 a.m. Employees for R.J. Noble witnessed the City employee enter the building at 11222 Acacia Parkway at 11:02 a.m. on the morning of May 11, 2022. (See attached declaration.) This was after these same employees for R.J. Noble witnessed the AAA runner give the unsealed bid packet to a City of Garden Grove Employee, who carried the unsealed envelope from 12860 Acacia Parkway to the rear entrance of City Hall, where she used a keypad to enter the building at approximately **11:02.** (See attached declaration.) As such, AAA failed to conform with the Bid Invitation.

Section (3) of the Notice of Bid Invitation provided:

In conformance with Section 37931 of the Government Code, all bids shall be presented under sealed cover on the proposal form provided and accompanied by one of the following forms of bidder's security:

- (a) Cash.
- (b) Cashier's check made payable to the City of Garden Grove.
- (c) A certified check made payable to the City of Garden Grove.
- (d) A bidder's bond executed by an admitted surety insurer, prepared on the forms provided and made payable to the City of Garden Grove.

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As discussed above, employees of R.J. Noble witnessed the AAA runner hand an unsealed envelope containing their bid to a city employee. This is a clear and direct violation of Section 37931 of the Government Code requiring bids to be sealed. Therefore, AAA's bid should be withdrawn from consideration.

II. AAA HAD GROSS TYPOGRAPHICAL AND/OR ARITHMETICAL ERRORS, SUCH THAT, AAA'S BID SHOULD HAVE BEEN WITHDRAWN FROM CONSIDERATION

AAA had gross typographical and/or arithmetical errors in their bid proposal submitted to the City of Garden Grove. (See **Exhibit B.**) On p. 37 of AAA's bid, the total bid written in words states "Four Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty Dollars." Further, the total bid written in figures states "\$478,930." These totals are also reflected in the City of Garden Grove's Preliminary Bid Results for the "Various Streets Rehabilitation 2022", wherein, the bid stated AAA's bid was \$478,930. (See **Exhibit C.**)

AAA's bid clearly includes a gross typographical and/or arithmetical error that should result in AAA's bid being withdrawn without forfeiting its Bid Bond per Public Contract Code section 5103. This is evidenced by the fact that the next closest bid (that of RJN) was \$4,971,340.00. Furthermore, this bid is clearly a gross typographical and/or arithmetical error in the fact that the City of Garden Grove Tabulation sheet has the AAA bid as worth more than \$4,000,000. (See **Exhibit D.**)

As a result, the City of Garden Grove was forced to fix AAA's faulty bid and gross typographical and/or arithmetical errors, which the City of Garden Grove was without the power to do. See *MCM Const., Inc. v. City & county of San Francisco* (1998) 66 Cal. App. 4th 359, 373-374 (holding that a city does not have the power to waive typographical and/or arithmetical errors regarding a bid). Further, if there is a material irregularity in the typographical or numerical error made by the bidder in filling out the Bid Forms, then the Public Agency has no leeway to ignore that error, as that kind of mistake gives the bidder who submitted the erroneous bid an unfair advantage over other bidders, as such errors provide legally sufficient grounds for withdrawing a bid without forfeiting its Bid Bond under Public Contract Code section 5103.

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As such, AAA's typographical and/or arithmetical errors cannot be overlooked or waived, and AAA's bid must be withdrawn from consideration.

III. AAA WAS PROVIDED ADVANTAGES THROUGHOUT THE BIDDING PROCESS WHICH SHOULD NOT BE SANCTIONED BY THIS CITY COUNCIL

As discussed above, AAA was given several advantages by the City of Garden Grove that were not afforded to the other bidders for this project. These advantages are each discussed above. Without these advantages, and the inherent bias against the other bidders created by same, AAA's bid would not have even been accepted, let alone chosen as the winning bid. This sort of disregard for the rules and practices for the public works bidding process will do nothing but generate clouds of suspicion among the taxpaying public and conforming bidders and provide opportunities for others in the future to gain unfair advantages in the public bidding process. This City Council should not condone, encourage, or otherwise sanction such actions.

As such, and pursuant to the above, this letter serves as the **OFFICIAL NOTICE OF APPEAL** of RJN as to the decision made by the City of Garden Grove, and the City Engineer Navin Maru, to award the "CITY OF GARDEN GROVE NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS FOR VARIOUS STREETS REHABILITATION 2022 PROJECT" to AAA. RJN hereby requests, pursuant to Code Section 2.60.020, that the City of Garden Grove City Council withdraw AAA's bid submitted for the "CITY OF GARDEN GROVE NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS FOR VARIOUS STREETS REHABILITATION 2022 PROJECT" and award the project to the lowest, responsible bidder - RJN.

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

6. Attention is directed to Section 3-1.01 of the Standard Specifications regarding the award of contract to the lowest responsible bidder.

The City reserves the right to reject the bid of any or all Bidders for any reason and to waive any informality or irregularity in the bids received. The City also reserves the right to withdraw this Invitation for Bids at any time for any reason without prior notice and the City makes no representations that the contract will be awarded to any Bidder responding to this Invitation for Bids.

The City also reserves the right to determine whether a Bidder is a responsible Bidder based on the Bidder's trustworthiness, quality, fitness, capacity, experience, and ability to perform as required under this Invitation for Bids. Any Bidder, or any officer of such Bidder, or an employee of such Bidder who has a proprietary interest in such Bidder, who has been disqualified, removed, or otherwise prevented from bidding on, or completing a federal, state, or local project because of a violation of law or a safety regulation, may be determined to be a non-responsible Bidder.

A designee or designees of the Public Works Director shall perform the evaluation of a Bidder's responsibility. When the Public Works Director's designee determines that a Bidder is disqualified as non-responsible, the Public Works Director's designee shall mail to the affected Bidder the disqualification determination, the basis for the determination, and any supporting evidence that the Public Works Director's designee received or relied on relating to such determination.

Any Bidder, who disagrees or disputes the non-responsible determination, may appeal such rating or determination. Such appeal may only be taken by filing a written notice of appeal with the City Manager within five working days after the Public Works Director's designee has mailed notice of the rating or determination. Within five working days of the receipt of an appeal, the City Manager, or a designee of the City Manager who has not been involved in the evaluation of qualifications of contractors for the subject project, shall conduct a hearing on the appeal. During the hearing, the affected Bidder shall have the opportunity to rebut any evidence used as a basis for the non-responsible determination and to present evidence to the City Manager or the City Manager's designee hearing the appeal as to why the Bidder should be found responsible. Within five working days of the conclusion of the hearing, the City Manager or the General Manager's designee hearing the appeal shall issue a written decision on the appeal and such decision shall be final.

7. The City Council has hereto determined the prevailing rate of per diem wages for the doing of said work, which said scale of wages is set forth by Resolution No. 5730 79 of the City Council, said resolution being on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Garden Grove, California, and is hereby made a part of and is incorporated herein.
8. Apprentices may be employed in conformity with Section 1777.5 and 1777.6 of the California Labor Code. Every apprentice shall be paid the standard wage paid to apprentices under the regulations of the trade at which he is employed. Information relative to employment of apprentices shall be obtained from the Director of Industrial Relations, who is the Administrative Officer of the California Apprenticeship Council.
9. Copies of all collective bargaining agreements relating to the work as set forth in the aforementioned Labor Code are on file and available for inspection in the office of the State of California, Department of Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Statistics and Research.
10. In order to help eliminate combinations or schemes, which restrain free competition in the procurement of bids on public construction projects and, in compliance with a request from the Department of Justice, **the completion of the "Questionnaire to General Contractors" is mandatory for a valid bid.** Said questionnaire is found in Section 4 of this document and is to be returned with bid proposal.
11. It is the policy of the City of Garden Grove to take positive steps to maximize the utilization of minority business enterprises in all contract activity administered by the City.

The Contractor will utilize his best efforts to carry out this policy in the award of his subcontracts to the fullest extent consistent with the efficient performance of this contract. As used in this contract, the term "minority business enterprise" means a business, at least 50 percent of which is owned by minority group members or, in the case of publicly owned businesses, at least 51

percent of the stock is owned by minority group members. For the purpose of this definition, minority group members are black, Hispanics, Asians, Native Americans, Alaskans, or Pacific Islanders.

12. **No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].**

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

13. **The CWA requires that the successful bidder in a covered project being awarded the contract to agree to abide by the CWA and to submit an executed Letter of Assent, the form of which is included in Section 4. The Letter of Assent shall be executed by the prime and all subcontractors and included with the bid submitted by bidders, in addition to the bid bond, subcontractor list, non-collusion affidavit, etc.**

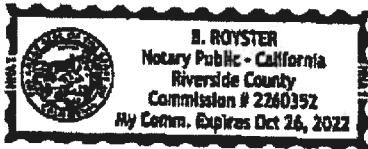

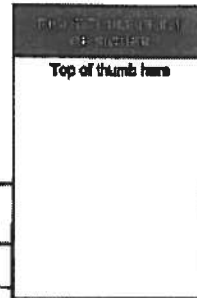
