All remarks and questions should be addressed to the City Council as a whole and not to individual Council Members or staff members. Any person making impertinent, slanderous, or profane remarks or who becomes boisterous while addressing the City Council shall be called to order by the Mayor. If such conduct continues, the Mayor may order the person barred from addressing the City Council any further during that meeting.

Time Limitation: Speakers must limit remarks for a total of (5) five minutes. When any group of persons wishes to address the City Council on the same subject matter, the Mayor may request a spokesperson be chosen to represent the group, so as to avoid unnecessary repetition. Project Purpose & Scope


The primary purpose of this safety project is to reduce the number and severity of collisions within the existing C-D Road.


- Reconfigure lane to create new connectors from EB SR-22 to SB I-5, and EB SR-22 to NB I-5 & NB SR-57.
- Reconfigure EB SR-22 mainline by striping to add one auxiliary lane for EB SR-22 to NB I-5 & NB SR-57 connector.
- Widen EB SR-22 to NB I-5/SR 57 connector (CONN 3 "the Horseshoe") to add one lane.
- Relocate the point of divergence easterly to Bristol Street/ La Veta Ave. interchange.
- Eliminate entrance to EB SR 22 from Bristol.
- Install new traffic control devices and upgrade existing traffic control devices.

Project Benefit

The propose improvements are expected to mitigate the congestion and waving issue within the existing C-D Road. In turn, it will reduced the number and severity of collisions.











Current Traffic Movement

OBJECTIVE

BACKGROUND

Korean immigrants arrived in the United States initiating the first chapter of Korean immigration on January 13, 1903, and in 2005, the United States Congress passed resolutions recognizing Korean American contributions to the economic growth and vitality of the United States. The Korean American community adds a rich and vibrant dimension to the diversity in Garden Grove.

Korean American Day

January 13, 2017

- WHEREAS, In 2005, the United States Congress unanimously passed resolutions to recognize Korean Americans who have made significant contributions to the economic vitality in the United States; and
- WHEREAS, January 13, 1903 marks the day the first group of Korean immigrants came to the United States in Honolulu, Hawaii, on the S.S. Gaelic. This year marks the 114th anniversary of their arrival; and
- WHEREAS, Today, more than 1.7 million Korean Americans call the United States their home, and in Garden Grove, our Korean American community is a large and vibrant one; and
- WHEREAS, Garden Grove's Sister City relationship with Anyang, Republic of Korea was built on mutual respect and admiration for their respective cultures in 1989; and
- WHEREAS, The City is very proud of the professional and cultural contributions made by Korean American business owners and residents in Garden Grove. They have helped our community's diversity become much richer in pride and heritage; and
- WHEREAS, The Korean American Federation of Orange County and the Korean American Chamber of Commerce of Orange County have been integral in helping many Korean American business owners and residents in Garden Grove become productive and proud citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Garden Grove does hereby proclaim January 13, 2017 as Korean American Day. The Garden Grove City Council does venerably recognize the contributions made by Korean Americans, and encourage all citizens to celebrate the community's diversity.

OBJECTIVE

To gain City Council approval to use moneys allocated from the Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Account (SLESA) for FY 2016-17 for approximately \$273,056, and to allocate these funds for front-line law enforcement services.

BACKGROUND

The Police Department receives an annual allocation from the State through the county Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Account (SLESA). SLESA funding for local government assists local law enforcement agencies by providing additional resources for front-line law enforcement services and/or capital projects that directly support such services, and is not intended to supplant current funding. The City's allocation for FY 2016-17 is approximately \$273,056. By statute, the monies allocated "...to a recipient entity shall be expended exclusively to provide front-line law enforcement services. These moneys shall not be used by local agencies to supplant other funding for Public Safety Services..." (Government Code §30062(a)).

DISCUSSION

Historically, the Department has utilized these funds to make purchases that directly support the delivery of front line law enforcement services, such as electronic citation devices and mobile computer terminals for patrol vehicles.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no impact to the City's General Fund as a result of this allocation.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Approve the acceptance of FY 2016-17 Supplemental Law Enforcement Service Account (SLESA) funds in the amount of \$273,056; and
- Authorize the allocation of these funds to the Police Department for front-line law enforcement services

OBJECTIVE

To present to the City Council a Resolution authorizing the termination of membership in the Orange County Regional Airport Authority, and the termination of the Authority and the Joint Powers Agreement.

BACKGROUND

The Orange County Regional Airport Authority (OCRAA) is a joint powers authority comprised of Orange County cities who actively pursued a suitable site for a commercial airport in Orange County since 1974. The City of Garden Grove became a Member of OCRAA on August 3, 1993.

The OCRAA had particular interest in the reuse of the former Marine Corps Air Station in El Toro. The Joint Powers Agreement included a termination clause stating that, "The Authority shall terminate, and its assets be distributed in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement, upon the sale or other disposition of all interest of the Authority in El Toro."

On July 2, 1999, the Federal Base Realignment and Closure Commission officially closed Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) El Toro. On February 16, 2005, the Lennar Corporation purchased the former MCAS El Toro property, which started the partnership between the City of Irvine, Lennar Corporation and the Federal Government in the creation of the Great Park. Thus, the need and purposes for the OCRAA terminated on February 16, 2005, when the Lennar Corporation purchased MCAS El Toro from the United States Navy. Additionally, a board of directors has not been appointed, nor has the OCRAA membership met since 2005.

DISCUSSION

The OCRAA Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement section (k) Termination of Authority

states, "The Authority shall terminate, and its assets be distributed in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement, upon; (a) the unanimous vote of its members; or (b) the sale or other disposition of all interest of the Authority in El Toro [and John Wayne]; or (c) the formation of an Airport District under the California Airport District Act, contained in California Public Utilities Code Section 22001, et seq., including the territories of all Members and all other cities and counties within the community impacted by the closure and re-use of El Toro, legally committed to the objectives and purposes of the Authority and governed by a Board of Directors elected at large throughout the District. Because MCAS El Toro will no longer be used as an airport, the OCRAA should be declared terminated.

The City of Garden Grove last served as treasurer and as headquarters for the OCRAA. The City has less than \$4,000 left over in the OCRAA account, which will be used to defray the costs of winding down the OCRAA.

The attached Resolution formally terminates the City's membership in OCRAA and directs the City Manager, or his designee, to notify the last known members of the OCRAA to take all actions necessary to confirm their termination of their membership in the OCRAA and termination of the OCRAA. The notice will report on the remaining funds deposited in the OCRAA account held by the City of Garden Grove. The resolution further directs that the leftover funds be transferred to the City of Garden Grove's General Fund to defray the cost of terminating and winding down the OCRAA. The termination will include notification to the Secretary of State.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There currently is less than \$4,000 in the OCRAA account. It is expected that this amount will be sufficient to finalize the termination and winding down of the OCRAA.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

 Adopt the Resolution authorizing the termination of membership in the Orange County Regional Airport Authority, and the termination of the Authority, and the Joint Powers Agreement.

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE AUTHORIZING THE TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP IN THE ORANGE COUNTY REGIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY, AND THE TERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY AND THE JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Orange County Regional Airport Authority (OCRAA) is a joint powers authority comprised of Orange County cities who actively pursued a suitable site for a commercial airport in Orange County since 1974; and

WHEREAS, on August 3, 1993 the City of Garden Grove approved resolution number 7601-93 and became a Member of OCRAA; and

WHEREAS, the OCRAA Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement section (j) states "Any Party may withdraw from the Authority at any time, for any reason, by giving written notice to the Board of its intention to do so thirty (30) days prior to a regulator meeting of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the OCRAA Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement section (k) Termination of Authority states "the Authority shall terminate, and its assets be distributed in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement, upon; (a) the unanimous vote of its members; or (b) the sale or other disposition of all interest of the Authority in El Toro [and John Wayne]; or (c) the formation of an Airport District under the California Airport District Act, contained in California Public Utilities Code Section 22001, et seq., including the territories of all Members and all other cities and counties within the community impacted by the closure and re-use of El Toro, legally committed to the objectives and purposes of the Authority and governed by a Board of Directors elected at large throughout the District; and

WHEREAS, on July 2, 1999 the Base Realignment and Closure Commission officially closed Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) El Toro.

WHEREAS, on February 16, 2005 the Lennar Corporation purchased the former MCAS El Toro property, which started the partnership between the City of Irvine, Lennar Corporation and the Federal Government in the creation of the Great Park.

WHEREAS, the OCRAA's interest in MCAS El Toro terminated on February 16, 2005 when the Lennar Corporation purchased MCAS El Toro from the United States Navy; and

WHEREAS, the need and purposes for the OCRAA terminated on February 16, 2005 when the Lennar Corporation purchased MCAS El Toro from the United States Navy; and

WHEREAS, a board of directors has not been appointed, nor has the OCRAA membership met since 2005; and

WHEREAS, the City of Garden Grove last served as treasurer and headquarters for the OCRAA, and minimal funds are left over in the OCRAA account.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Termination of Membership in OCRAA. That the City of Garden Grove's membership in OCRAA is hereby confirmed terminated.

<u>Section 2</u>. Termination of the OCRAA. That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to notify the last known members of the OCRAA to take all actions necessary to confirm their termination of their membership in the OCRAA and termination of the OCRAA. The notice shall report on the remaining funds deposited in the OCRAA account held by the City of Garden Grove, which funds shall be transferred to the City of Garden Grove's General Fund to defray the cost of terminating and winding down of the OCRAA. The City manager, or his designee, shall further take all actions necessary to formally terminate and wind down the OCRAA, including notification of the State agencies with jurisdiction thereof, as may be required by law.

<u>Section 3</u>. Termination of the OCRAA Account. The OCRAA account held by the City of Garden Grove shall be closed and any remaining funds shall be transferred to the City of Garden Grove General Fund to defray the cost of terminating and winding down the OCRAA.

OBJECTIVE

For the City Council to hold a Public Hearing to consider the adoption of the attached Resolution (attachment 1) amending user fees for Advanced Life Support and Non-Resident First Responder.

BACKGROUND

In 1994, the City Council adopted a Master Fee Schedule, which combined the City's fees for service into one document. Within the Master Fee Schedule, under Fire Department, the City has an Advanced Life Support (ALS) fee and a Non-Resident First Responder fee.

The ALS fee is regulated by the County of Orange and adopted by local agencies. The County of Orange's rate adjustments are based on the cost of providing the service and adjusted for inflation by the change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI). Data from the U.S. Department of Labor Bureau of Labor Statistics is used to determine the percentage change in the annual "all items" CPI for the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County areas from the prior year and calculate any proposed rate change. The City Council established and adopted the regulated County of Orange ALS fee on September 8, 1998, at \$200.00 per call, and amended the rate to \$225.00 on June 22, 2004, and then to \$350.00 on June 9, 2009. At this same June 9th meeting, the Non-Resident First Responder fee was established and adopted at \$350.00 to offset paramedic level services provided to non-residents in the city. Since the non-resident fee is for ALS level paramedic services, the rate mirrors the County of Orange regulated ALS rate.

DISCUSSION

An increase to the current ALS and Non-Resident First Responder fees is necessary to recover the costs of providing the services and to be in line with the current regulated County of Orange ALS rate of \$387.35. A Public Hearing Notice was published on December 21, 2016, in accordance with Government Code Section 6062(a).

The proposed fee changes and documentation were made available for the ten day public review period at the City Clerk's Office since December 21, 2016. If approved, the new fees will become effective immediately following adoption of the attached Resolution.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

It is estimated that the proposed fee updates will recover approximately an additional \$ 56,324 annually.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that City Council:

- Conduct the Public Hearing; and
- Adopt the attached Resolution amending user fees for Advanced Life Support and Non-Resident First Responder.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE ESTABLISHING AND AMENDING ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT AND NON-RESIDENT FIRST RESPONDER FEES

WHEREAS, State law authorizes a city to adopt and implement fees, rates, and charges for municipal services, provided that such fees, rates, and charges do not exceed the estimated reasonable cost of providing such services;

WHEREAS, the Fire Department of the City of Garden Grove has identified certain services provided to members of the public and organizations;

WHEREAS, the actual and direct costs to the City to provide these services have been calculated and analyzed, and where the cost of such services have changed, a revised fee or charge has been determined as set forth in Schedule A attached hereto;

WHEREAS, pursuant to legal notice, a Public Hearing was held by the City Council on January 10, 2017, and all interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, all legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Garden Grove does hereby establish revised fees and charges as set forth in Schedule A attached hereto. The revised fees and charges in Schedule A supersede any fees and charges previously adopted for the same service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in order to provide the public an easy-to-understand schedule of fees, the City Clerk is directed to compile and make available upon request an updated schedule of fees and charges for City services that combines: (1) the list of previously-established service fees and charges that are not addressed by this Resolution, with (2) the list of services subject to revised fees and charges attached hereto as Schedule A. The combined list is for public information purposes, and clerical or other errors or omissions in the preparation of the list shall not have the effect of increasing, decreasing, invalidating, or waiving adopted fees or charges.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the fees attached in Schedule A shall become effective immediately following the adoption of this resolution.

ORDINANCE NO. 2877

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE ENACTING REGULATIONS FOR THE PAYMENT OF DRAINAGE FACILITIES FEES AND CITYWIDE PARK FEES, INCLUDING REVISIONS TO TITLES 9 AND 10 OF THE GARDEN GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE AMENDING CHAPTER 9.44 TO CODIFY THE REQUIREMENTS FOR PARKLAND DEDICATION AND FEES FOR NEW SUBDIVISIONS AND AMENDING CHAPTER 10.110 TO PROVIDE FOR UPDATES TO TRAFFIC MITIGATION FEES PURSUANT TO DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEE STUDIES

City Attorney Summary

This Ordinance enacts regulations for the payment of drainage facilities fees and citywide park fees for new development projects. The park fees are only applicable to new residential projects. The Ordinance further codifies more specific requirements for the dedication of parkland and/or the payment of an in-lieu fee applicable to new residential subdivisions and adds a provision to the traffic impact mitigation fee regulations allowing the fee to be adjusted pursuant to development impact fee studies. The ordinance does not set the amount of each fee. The regulations being codified by this Ordinance require that the City Council set the amount of the fees by Resolution.

WHEREAS, State law authorizes the City to adopt development impact fees to mitigate the impacts to the City's infrastructure caused by development projects; and

WHEREAS, Willdan Financial Services has prepared a Development Impact Fee Study dated July 6, 2016, analyzing the level of fees required to support future development in the City through 2030 and determining the future development's share of the cost of public facilities and capital improvements for parks, transportation and drainage facilities required as a result of such development;

WHEREAS, Citywide Park Fees and In-Lieu Park Fees are required to provide funding for the development of City parks to accommodate the residents of development projects, which create a need for and demand upon park facilities, when developers of such projects do not develop park facilities and/or dedicate park land or sufficient amounts thereof;

WHEREAS, Citywide Park Fees and In-Lieu Park Fees are applied to development projects based upon the impacts that such projects have on park facilities and the need therefor;

WHEREAS, Transportation Facilities Fees provide funding for necessary improvements to the transportation system to accommodate development, which development creates a need for and demand upon the transportation system;

WHEREAS, Transportation Facilities Fees are applied to development projects based upon the impacts that such projects have on Transportation Facilities and the need therefor;

WHEREAS, Drainage Facilities Fees provide funding for necessary improvements to the drainage system to accommodate development, which development creates a need for and demand upon the drainage system;

WHEREAS, Drainage Facilities Fees are applied to development projects based upon the impacts that such projects have on drainage system facilities and the need therefor; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of the Willdan Financial Services fee study requires revisions to the Municipal Code to clarify the imposition of the fees to be set by Resolution of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> Chapter 9.44 of Title 9 of the Garden Grove Municipal Code is hereby revised in its entirety to read as follows:

CHAPTER 9.44

MITIGATION FEES

Section 9.44.010 Fees for Development Projects

The following fees are required to mitigate impacts to City infrastructure created by development projects.

- A. Traffic Impact Mitigation Fees pursuant to Chapter 10.110 of this Code.
- B. Water Assessment Fee pursuant to Chapter 14.24 of this Code.
- C. General Plan and Cultural Arts Fee pursuant to Chapter 3.48 of this Code.
- D. Drainage Facilities Fees pursuant to this Chapter.
- E. Park Fees pursuant to this Chapter.
- F. Parkway Tree Fee pursuant to Chapter 9.40 of this Code.

Section 9.44.020 Drainage Facilities Fee

New development generates storm water runoff by increasing the amount of land that is impervious to precipitation and such runoff must be controlled through

storm drain facilities. A Drainage Facilities Fee is hereby established to mitigate the costs of new or expanded storm drain facilities required as a result of new development. The fee shall be in such amounts as established by Resolution of the City Council.

Section 9.44.030 In-Lieu Park Fees (Quimby)

A. Park Dedication and In-Lieu Fee Requirement for Subdivisions.

In accordance with Government Code 66477, every residential subdivider who creates a subdivision shall be required to dedicate land, pay a fee in lieu thereof, or do a combination of both, as established in this section for the purpose of providing park and recreational facilities to serve future residents of the subdivision. Said park and recreational facilities shall be reasonably accessible for use by the future inhabitants of said subdivision.

B. Relation of Land Required to Population Density.

Consistent with the General Plan, it is hereby found and determined that the public interest, convenience, health, welfare and safety require that two (2) acres of land for each 1,000 persons residing within the city be devoted to public park and recreational purposes.

C. Population Density.

For the purposes of this section, population density shall be established by Resolution of the City Council, utilizing the following classifications:

- 1. Single-family residential. Detached single-family homes where there is no more than one (1) dwelling unit on a lot.
- 2. Multiple-family residential. Apartments, common interest developments, townhouses and similar multiple-family residential developments, including detached single-family homes where there is more than one (1) dwelling unit on a lot.
- D. Amount of Land to be Dedicated.

The amount of land required to be dedicated by a subdivider pursuant to this section shall be based on the following formula:

$$A = 2(DF X DU)/1,000$$

Where:

A - Is the area in acres required to be dedicated as park sites.

- 2 Is the number of acres for park area per 1000 persons required by the General Plan.
- DF Is the population density factor established by Resolution of the City Council pursuant to subdivision (C), as applicable to the proposed development.
- DU Is the number of dwelling units proposed for the development. When the actual number of units is unknown, the number of the units shall be based on the maximum number of units which are permitted by the General Plan and this Title for the property at the time the tentative or parcel map is filed with the City.

E. Amount of Fee In Lieu of Land Dedication.

- 1. Where there is no public park or recreation facility required or provided within or for the proposed subdivision, or where the subdivision contains 50 lots or fewer, the subdivider shall pay a fee in lieu of land dedication reflecting the value of land required for park and recreation purposes in accordance with the schedule of fees as adopted by Resolution of the City Council. This fee shall reflect the amount of land that would otherwise be required to be dedicated under subdivision (D) multiplied by the estimated cost of land acquisition within the City.
- 2. Nothing in this section shall prohibit the dedication and acceptance of land for park and recreation purposes in subdivisions of 50 lots or fewer, where the subdivider proposes the dedication voluntarily and the land is accepted by the City Council.
- 3. When a common interest development project, stock cooperative, or community apartment project exceeds 50 dwelling units, the City may elect to require dedication of land notwithstanding that the number of lots may be 50 lots or fewer.
- 4. For subdivisions in excess of 50 lots, the City Council may elect to accept a fee in lieu of land dedication. The amount of such a fee shall be based upon the fair market value of land which would otherwise be required for dedication. The fair market value shall be determined by an M.A.I. appraisal acceptable to the City and at the expense of the developer. If more than one year elapses between the date of the appraisal and recording of the final map, the City shall have prepared a new appraisal and shall invoice the subdivider for the cost of the appraisal.
- 5. If the subdivider objects to the amount of the in-lieu fee required pursuant to this section, an appeal may be made to the City Council pursuant to Chapter 2.60 of this Code.
- 6. The fee collected shall be deposited and held in appropriate accounts to be expended only for the purpose of developing new or rehabilitating existing

neighborhood or community park or recreation facilities to serve the subdivision on which the fee is charged.

F. Credits.

- 1. When park and recreational facilities, including equipment, are provided by the subdivider to dedicated land, the value of the recreational facilities or equipment as determined by the City Council, upon the recommendation of the Community Services Director, shall be a credit against the fees to be paid or land to be dedicated pursuant to this section; provided that the recreational facilities or equipment have been made or installed with the prior approval and to the satisfaction of the Community Services Director.
- 2. Credit shall not be allowed for single purpose commercial recreation facilities whether dedicated or in private ownership.
 - 3. No credit shall be given for private park open space in any subdivision.
 - G. Time for Payment of Fees and Dedication of Land.

At the time of approval of the tentative tract map or parcel map, the City shall determine the amount of land to be dedicated, and/or the amount of fees to be paid by the subdivider. At the time the final tract or parcel map is submitted to the City Council for approval, the subdivider shall dedicate the land and/or pay required inlieu fees.

Section 9.44.040 Citywide Park Fees

Every residential developer who creates a residential development not subject to Chapter 9.40 (Subdivisions) of this Code shall be required to remit a park fee as established by Resolution of the City Council for the purpose of providing citywide park and recreational facilities. The provisions of this section shall apply to all residential developments, which are not subdivided and subject to Government Code Section 66000 et seq.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> Section 9.40.140(C) of Chapter 9.40 of Title 9 of the Garden Grove Municipal Code is hereby revised to read as follows (deletions in **strikethrough**, additions in **bold**):

- C. Parks and Recreation **Facilities** Dedication Facilities.
- 1. Dedication of Park Land Required. The subdivider shall dedicate land, or pay a fee in lieu thereof, or a combination of both, as a condition of approval, for the

purpose of providing parks and recreational facilities for future inhabitants of said subdivision as provided for in Section 9.44.030.

- 2. Relationship to General Plan. The amount and location of land to be dedicated shall be determined by the City Council according to the standards and principles contained in the recreation element of the General Plan, and any amendments thereto, and said park and recreation facilities shall be reasonably accessible for use by the future inhabitants of said subdivision.
- 3. Fee in Lieu of Dedication. In lieu of such park land dedication, the City Council, at its option may require payment of a fee or a combination of dedication and fee. Said dedication and fee shall be established by the City Council by resolution.

<u>SECTION 3:</u> Section 10.110.020 of Chapter 10.110 of Title 10 of the Garden Grove Municipal Code is hereby revised to read as follows (deletions in strikethrough, additions in **bold**):

10.110.020 Establishment of a Transportation Improvement Program

An analysis of the need for public transportation roadway improvements required by new development was conducted and is set forth in a study entitled "Revised Transportation System Improvement Program," which is on file in the office of the City Traffic Engineer. Said study sets forth the relationship between new developments, the needed improvements, and the estimated costs of those improvements. Additional traffic and transportation facilities studies or development impact fee studies may be conducted from time to time to update and support the resolution establishing the facilities and fees required to provide for the transportation roadway improvements required by new development.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: Section 10.110.030 of Chapter 10.110 of Title 10 of the Garden Grove Municipal Code is hereby revised to amend subdivision (F) and add subdivision (G) to read as follows (deletions in strikethrough, additions in **bold**):

F. CREDIT FOR CERTAIN STREET WIDENING IMPROVEMENTS. The traffic impact mitigation fee street widening improvements costs include certain items that may be constructed by a developer whose project is located on an arterial highway as indicated in Tables II and III of the "Revised Transportation System Improvement Program." If the City Traffic Engineer determines that the developer is constructing eligible street widening improvements included in the most current Transportation Facilities Study or Development Impact Fee Study (right-of-way dedication is not an eligible credit), the developer shall receive credit against the traffic impact mitigation fee. In no case shall the credit exceed the traffic impact mitigation fee applicable to the project.

G. CREDIT FOR PRIOR OR EXISTING PROJECTS. In order for a developer to receive credit towards the traffic impact mitigation fee for a prior or existing project, the establishment of the use of the prior or existing project must have been operational after January 1, 1991. The determination of the credit will be based on the most current Transportation Facilities Study or Development Impact Fee Study applicable at the time the credit is requested. In no case shall the credit exceed the traffic impact mitigation fee applicable to the project for which the credit is requested.

<u>SECTION 5</u>: Subdivision (C) of Section 10.110.050 of Chapter 10.110 of Title 10 of the Garden Grove Municipal Code is hereby deleted as follows (deletions in strikethrough):

C. Small traffic generators such as walk in sandwich shops/coffee shops that do not increase restaurant type business in the center over 20% of the total floor space in the existing center.

<u>SECTION 6</u>: If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, word, or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, word, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, words or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

<u>SECTION 7</u>: The Mayor shall sign and the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same, or the summary thereof, to be published and posted pursuant to the provisions of law and this Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after adoption.

Department regarding the proposed Facility Usage Agreement for the Festival Amphitheater with the LFA Group, LLC, as requested by

City Manager Stiles.

OBJECTIVE

The purpose of this memorandum and presentation is to transmit information to the City Council regarding a proposal from LFA Group, LLC, for the use of the Festival Amphitheater.

BACKGROUND

For nearly 15 years, the 540-seat Festival Amphitheater has served as home to Shakespeare OC, the only professional Shakespearean theater group in Orange County. In 2003, the City entered into an Agreement with Tom Bradac (Bradac) to serve as the operator of the Festival Amphitheater. As the theater operator, Bradac facilitated the variety of uses by different groups including the Boys and Girls Clubs of Garden Grove, United Methodist Church of Garden Grove, Strawberry Festival Association, Shakespeare OC and various independent users.

In 2013, John Walcutt took over Shakespeare Orange County (SOC) and continued the summer tradition at the Amphitheater from May through September. Additionally that year, the City entered into an agreement with M&D Silva Enterprises dba Strawberry Productions, Inc. (M&D), to operate the theater from October through April. M&D expanded cultural arts within the community by bringing movies, concerts and comedy performances to the theater and continue to do so. Both agreements expire December 31, 2018.

DISCUSSION

In November 2016, the City received a proposal from the LFA Group, LLC, to manage operations at the Festival Amphitheater. The attached proposal, offers both

the addition of professional sound and lighting equipment and the promise of capital facility improvements, in lieu of rent, over a period of three (3) years. While LFA Group, LLC, proposes to lease the Festival Amphitheater, staff will instead entertain a Facilities Use Agreement with LFA Group, LLC. City staff has met with SOC and M&D about this proposal. Both parties are supportive of the initiative, given the opportunity to realize significant technical and capital improvements at the facility.

LFA Group, LLC, has experience in the entertainment and restaurant industry, including the development of several night clubs, bars and restaurants, as well as concert promotion and concert venues. Collectively, the LFA Group, LLC, brings more than 35 years of entertainment and food experience to the table and their experience shows that they are experienced operators.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact to the City's General Fund in the consideration of this Agreement.

RECOMMENDATION

This presentation is to provide information regarding the LFA Group, LLC. An Agreement will brought forward to the City Council for consideration at the meeting scheduled for January 24, 2017.

Viet Tran graduated from UCLA in 1999 with Bachelors in Economics. He was the marketing director at the Shark Club (12K sqft) for 12 years and at V2O The Venue (30K sqft) for 2 years. He owns Limelight, a venue management and marketing company in Orange County. He also owns Dos Chinos the food truck, which now has 2 brick and mortar locations in Santa Ana and soon to have another 2 in Irvine.

OBJECTIVE

The company's objective is to redevelop and program the amphitheater into a multi-purpose entertainment venue to accommodate live entertainment, special events, and multi-media productions.

The surrounding cities of Irvine, Costa Mesa, and Anaheim are all expanding their live entertainment spaces. Irvine Meadows Amphitheater has closed and will be relocating to the Great Parks, House of Blues at Downtown Disney has also closed and expanding to a larger space at the Anaheim Garden Walk, and Pacific Amphitheater in Costa Mesa has ramped up their bookings.

The Strawberry Bowl Amphitheater will be transformed into an exciting destination for live entertainment by curating artists and shows that are current, diverse, and relevant. It will provide up close and personal outdoor experiences that are not available in the current market. Eventually it will become a launching platform for artists in the way Detroit Bar was for bands such as Foster the People, Cold War Kids, Local Natives, Miike Snow, The Neighborhood, Aloe Blacc, and more. New foot traffic and recognition from the amphitheater will help activate Downtown Garden Grove and increase business to the surrounding area.

LEASE & PERMITS

LFA is proposing a new 10-year lease with two (2) additional 5-year options to extend beyond the initial term at \$1500/month. In lieu of rent for the years 1 to 5, LFA Group, LLC will guarantee a minimum investment \$125,000 to improve and update the facility within the first 3 years of the lease. At the time of occupancy, an assessment of the amphitheater will be conducted to determine the required repairs and improvements.

LFA Group, LLC will require the ability to do live entertainment with operational hours up to 11:00pm with restricted sound amplification after 10:00pm.

LFA Group, LLC will develop and activate larger scale events in the Village Green Park such as music festivals, food fairs, and concerts.

REVENUE SOURCES

LFA will book live entertainment (indie bands, comedy, and theater), corporate meetings/seminars, and special events (holiday, non profit, and private) at the amphitheater. The company understands that there are currently agreements with Shakespeare OC and Strawberry Productions and is willing to work with both.
